Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

Knowledge

- > SAP Measures (quantitative & qualitative)
 - > Pace or Completion Rate
 - > 67% min
 - > 150% program length
 - > GPA
- > Warning
 - > IF SAP measured each payment period
 - > Only lasts one payment period
- > Appeals
 - > Probation
 - > Only lasts one payment period
 - > Only if student can make SAP after one payment period
 - > Academic Plans
 - > Required if not eligible for Probation but Appeal is approved

Repeated Course Work

Knowledge

- May repeat one time if passed
- May repeat multiple times if failed
- Certain types of classes are not considered repeat
 - Example: Music majors enrolled in vocal each semester as required by program
