All award ranges and terms are subject to change by federal, state and/or institutional guidelines.

***\* Most programs require a FAFSA for the academic year you are applying for.***

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** The service scholarship programs require a commitment to service. If the service obligation is not fulfilled the scholarship funding received must be repaid with interest.

Kansas Nursing Service Scholarship	Requires commitment to practice as a LPN or RN in Kansas and work for a sponsor. Kansas Teacher Service Scholarship	Requires commitment to teach in Kansas. Kansas Military Service Scholarship	No repayment. Kansas National Guard Educational Assistance	Requires commitment to serve in the Kansas National Guard for 24 months following the last semester in which they received scholarship funding. Kansas Career Technical Workforce Grant	No repayment. Kansas Tuition Waiver Programs: Foster Care; Dependents & Spouses of Deceased Public Safety Officers; Prisoners of War; and Dependents & Spouses of Deceased Military Personnel	No repayment. ROTC Service Scholarship	Requires commitment to serve in Kansas National Guard for no less than 4 years as a second lieutenant	KS residents	12 credit hours	Contact the ROTC program at one of the participating schools for more information.

**WORKSTUDY:** Awards are earned through employment either on-campus or in the community and are paid in the form of a regular paycheck.

<b>Federal Workstudy*</b>	Work at an hourly rate at a job on campus. Financial need is required.	Undergraduate and graduate students	6 credit hours	File the FAFSA.
<b>Kansas Career Workstudy</b>	Work in a career-related position off-campus.	Kansas residents: undergraduate and graduate students	6 credit hours	Information available at institution of choice.

**GRANTS:** Awards in this category generally do not have to be repaid. Financial need is required.

<b>Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG)*</b>	No repayment.	Pell-eligible undergraduate students	Any level of enrollment	File the FAFSA.
<b>Kansas Comprehensive Grant*</b>	No repayment.	KS resident undergraduate students working on a first degree	12 credit hours	File the FAFSA.
<b>Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education Grant (TEACH)</b>	No repayment if you meet service obligation.	Undergraduate and graduate students planning to begin a career teaching in a high-need subject area in a school which serves low-income students	Award varies according to enrollment	File the FAFSA and contact the Financial Aid Office if you are interested in completing coursework necessary for you to become an elementary or secondary school teacher.

**LOANS:** The borrower must repay awards in this category even if the student does not complete his/her academic program.

<b>Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan</b>	Interest changes annually based on the market. Repayment begins 6 months after leaving school. <b>Federal Parent PLUS Loan</b>	Interest changes annually based on the market. Repayment begins 60 days after the final disbursement.	Biological or adoptive parents or step-parents (whose information appears on the FAFSA) of dependent students.	6 credit hours	File the FAFSA and parent must submit a Request for a Direct Plus Loan online at <a href="https://studentloans.gov">https://studentloans.gov</a> .
<b>Federal Graduate PLUS Loan</b>	Interest changes annually based on the market. Repayment begins 60 days after leaving school.	Graduate students	5 credit hours; if you drop below 5 credit hours, your repayment schedule begins.	File the FAFSA and submit a Request for a Direct Plus Loan online at <a href="https://studentloans.gov">https://studentloans.gov</a> .
<b>Alternative/Private Loans</b>	Varies by lender.	Undergraduate students, graduate students, and international students.	Varies by lender	Information about private/alternative loan programs is available at institution of choice.
